



Course #521: How to Comply with the Truck and Bus Regulation

The Truck and Bus Regulation applies to privately and federally-owned diesel trucks and buses, with a gross vehicle weight rating (GVWR) greater than 14,000 pounds that operate in California. Requirements for the regulation began January 1, 2012 and are phased-in annually through January 1, 2023. Truck owners and operators, as well as brokers, dispatchers, and fleet managers are responsible for compliance.
