## TOXIC RISK ASSESSMENT POLICY

- 1) Sources that emit Toxic Air Contaminants, as listed by ARB or EPA, must apply for a permit.
- 2) A screening risk assessment will be performed by the District. If the lifetime carcinogenic risk to the maximum exposed individual is less than or equal to one-in-one-million ( $1 \times 10^{-6}$ ), a permit will be granted. If the risk is greater than  $1 \times 10^{-6}$  the proponent will be required to do a formal risk assessment and an Environmental Impact Report.
- 3) Proposed sources which result in a carcinogenic risk of greater than  $10 \times 10^{-6}$  would be denied permits. Proposed sources which result in a carcinogenic risk between  $1 \times 10^{-6}$  and  $10 \times 10^{-6}$  may be issued a permit if appropriate mitigations are incorporated into the project.
