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NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING GREAT BASIN UNIFIED AIR POLLUTION CONTROL DISTRICT ADOPTION OF SUPPLEMENTAL SB 270 FEE ASSESSMENT AND ORDER

The Governing Board of the Great Basin Unified Air Pollution Control District (District) will conduct a public hearing for the purpose of considering and adopting a supplemental SB 270 fee assessment and order pursuant to California Health and Safety Code Section 42316 and an Order adopted by the District Governing Board on May 16, 2011. The supplemental fee assessment is for administrative legal services and fees relative to implementing, defending and enforcing the District's 2011 Supplemental Control Requirement Determination (2011 SCR D).

California Health and Safety Code Section 42316 requires the City of Los Angeles to pay fees to the District based on an estimate of the actual costs to the District for activities associated with the development of mitigation measures and related air quality analysis due to air quality impacts of the City of Los Angeles' water diversion, conveyance and storage activities. The California Air Resources Board has determined that the subject legal services are a permissible category of fees under Section 42316. A copy of the fee summary and proposed order is available for inspection at the District office at the address shown below.

The public hearing will be conducted at a regular meeting of the District Governing Board to be held at 10:30 a.m. on Monday, December 5, 2011, Mono County Board of supervisors Chambers, Mono County Courthouse (2nd Floor), Main Street, Bridgeport, California. The public hearing on the special fee assessment is set for 10:35 a.m. Written comments are invited, and should be addressed to Ms. Tori DeHaven, Clerk of the Board, Great Basin Unified Air Pollution Control District, 157 Short Street, Bishop, California 93514. Written comments received by the close of business Tuesday, November 15, 2011 will be included in the staff report sent to the Governing Board members.
