

**Keeler Dunes Dust Mitigation Project

**Addendum 3
May 16, 2014**

The BLM has placed some additional requirements on this project related to cultural monitoring.

1. Cultural monitoring must be provided for the entire active construction period, not just for 30 days and not just in “culturally sensitive areas”.
2. One tribal monitor must be retained for the entire active construction period.
3. One “qualified archaeologist” must be retained for the entire active construction period.
The definition of a “qualified archaeologist” is:

Qualified Archeologist Requirement

The minimum professional qualifications in archeology for the Keeler Dunes Project include a graduate degree in archeology, anthropology, or closely related field plus:

1. At least one year of full-time professional experience or equivalent specialized training in archeological research, administration or management;
2. At least four months of supervised field and analytic experience in general North American archeology, and
3. Demonstrated ability to carry work to completion.
4. Demonstrated experience in the Owens Valley
5. At least one year of full-time professional experience at a supervisory level in the study of North American archeological resources of the prehistoric and the historic periods.
