Instructions for Authority to Construct/Permit to Operate Application Section A-3 Fuel Burning Equipment

- 1. <u>Person Completing Form</u>: Name of Person completing form, date, information for calendar year, and APCD application number, if known.
- 2. <u>Facility Operating Schedule</u>: Facility operating schedule for the source as a whole.
- 3. <u>Reference Number</u>: Assign and identifying number for each boiler, furnace, kiln, space heater, etc. and use the same reference number for information on each of the three pages of Section A-3.
- 4. <u>Equipment Manufacturer and Model Number</u>: Nameplate data for fuel burning equipment.
- 5. Rated Heat Input Capacity: Rated heat input capacity in BTU per hour.
- 6. <u>Type of Burner Unit</u>: Use burner codes listed at the bottom of the form. If the type is not on the list, enter (104) and specify the type.
- 7. <u>Usage</u>: Type of fuel burning equipment; use usage codes listed at the bottom of the form. If the type of usage is not listed, enter (05) and specify the type.
- 8. <u>Heat Usage</u>: Enter the percent of heat generated by the equipment used in process operations and the percent used for space heating of the buildings.
- 9. Person Completing Form: Name of person completing form, date and APCD application number, if known.
- 10. <u>Reference Number</u>: Use the same numbers from page 1 of Section A-3 to identify information for the same fuel-burning unit.

11. Stack of Exhaust Data:

- A. Stack height in feet, from ground level.
- B. Stack exit diameter, in feet or inches.
- C. Stack exit gas velocity, in feet per minute.
- D. Stack exit gas volume, in actual cubic feet per minute.
- E. Stack exit gas temperature, in degrees Fahrenheit.

12. Fuel(s) Data:

- A. Amount of fuel burned per hour. Specify gallon, tons, cubic feet, etc.
- B. Amount of fuel burned per year. Specify gallon, tons, cubic feet, etc.
- C. Heat content of fuel. Amount of BTU per pound, gallon, cubic feet, etc. Specify.
- D. Sulfur content of fuel. Average percentage.

Ash content of fuel. Average percentage.

If percentage of ash and sulfur are unknown, list the fuel type (coal, gas, propane, wood, #6 oil, etc.) and the dealer who supplies the fuel at the bottom of the form in the blanks provided so that the District may obtain information from the dealer.

- 13. <u>Person Completing Form</u>: Name of person completing form, date and APCD application number, if known.
- 14. Reference Number: Use the same numbers from pages 1 & 2 of section A-3 to identify information for the same fuel-burning unit.

15. <u>Air Pollution Control Equipment:</u>

- A. Manufacturer and Model Number. Nameplate data for control equipment.
- B. Type. Use Air Pollution Control Equipment Codes at the bottom of the form. If type is not listed, enter (014) and specify type.
- C. Design efficiency. Enter the percent efficiency of pollutants removal that the control equipment was designed for, if known.
- D. Actual efficiency. Enter the actual removal efficiency of the equipment if tests have been made to determine the efficiency.
- 16. <u>Emission Rates</u>: Specify the tons per year of each of the listed pollutants actually emitted into the air and give the basis for the estimation (stack tests, emission factors, material balances, etc.).
