## **TOXIC RISK ASSESSMENT POLICY**

- 1) Sources that emit Toxic Air Contaminants, as listed by ARB or EPA, must apply for a permit.
- 2) A screening risk assessment will be performed by the District. If the lifetime carcinogenic risk to the maximum exposed individual is less than or equal to one-in-one-million (1x10<sup>-6</sup>), a permit will be granted. If the risk is greater than 1x10<sup>-6</sup> the proponent will be required to do a formal risk assessment and an Environmental Impact Report.
- Proposed sources which result in a carcinogenic risk of greater than 10x10 <sup>-6</sup> would be denied permits. Proposed sources which result in a carcinogenic risk between 1x10 <sup>-6</sup> and 10x10 <sup>-6</sup> may be issued a permit if appropriate mitigations are incorporated into the project.
